

## Milwaukee Bay J-24 Fleet Racing

June 2 through August 25, 2022

### Notice of Race

#### 1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)

1.2 Sailing instructions will consist of Standard Sailing Instructions. Supplemental sailing instructions will be on the notice board at MCSC. Sailing instructions may be given on the water before the start of a race.

#### 2 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats in the J-24 class affiliated with a Milwaukee Bay sailing organization (MYC, SSYC, MCSC, or MAST).

2.2 A boat must have given proof of \$300,000 liability insurance (which includes a racing provision) and a signed waiver of liability and covenant not to sue on file at MCSC in order to be eligible.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form and sending in the required fee to MCSC, 1450 N Lincoln Memorial Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53202. Attention to Teresa.

2.4 Entry must be received in order for a boat to be scored.

#### 3 Fees

3.1 Required fees are as follows: \$150 per boat.

3.2 MCSC race certified skippers using MCSC J-24's and MCSC members as crew will have that fee waived. Any changes to 3.2 require special permission from MCSC executive staff (Director, Development Director, Program Manager), a \$10 fee per race, and any applicable guest fee.

#### 4 Schedule

4.1 Registration: Registration must be received and processed before June 2, 2022. Your boat will not be scored until all required documents and fee are received.

4.2 Thursday evenings starting June 2 and ending after racing on August 25, 2022.

4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1810. This may change on agreement of all participants and MCSC staff.

4.4 The warning signal of the last race each night will not be made after 60 minutes before sunset.

## 5 Measurement

5.1 A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1

## 6 Sailing Instructions

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 6/1/2022. They will be electronically distributed to registered boats. A paper copy will be posted on the MCSC notice board.

## 7 The Courses

7.1 Races will take place behind the Milwaukee breakwater, unless the race committee decides otherwise. Courses will be windward-leeward or triangle.

## 8 Penalty System

8.1 RRS 44.1 will be in effect. Rule 44.2 will apply.

## 9 Scoring

9.1 The scoring system is as follows: Appendix A4

## 10 Prizes

10.1 There will be a trophy presentation at the end of the season. Awards will be given for first, second, and third place based on scores for the season. The Race Committee reserves the right to award additional trophies.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
